Celebrating the Next Phase of Hermann Bark

On February 22, 2022, Hermann Park Conservancy officially broke ground on the McWilliams Dog Park. Humans and canines alike came together to celebrate the latest improvement project in Hermann Park.

Bordered by MacGregor Drive and Brays Bayou at the southern tip of the Park, the McWilliams Dog Park is a 2.6-acre site, with dedicated spaces for large and small dogs, interactive water features, canine play equipment, ample shade for dogs and their owners, and dedicated on-site parking.

When creating the new master plan, a new dog park was the most requested feature from the community. Now, after many rounds of design and troubleshooting, Hermann Park's furry friends will finally have a place of their own when the McWilliams Dog Park opens this winter.

While construction begins at the dog park site, fundraising is still ongoing and we are currently at 95% of our \$2 million goal. If you would like to help us reach our goal and have a paw-sitive impact on Hermann Park, then please visit hermannpark.org/doggydonate.

We invest years working with the finest landscape architects and design teams to fine-tune every detail so that each finished project improves the Park's health while delighting our visitors. But this careful planning is just the foundation. Each project only comes to life with the generous support of our members and donors like you. Yet to Park visitors, I am sure this in-depth collaboration feels like magic as they experience the joys of the Park.

Her reply: "It's either magic or good engineering." Well, ok, then — magic gets an assist from the good engineers!

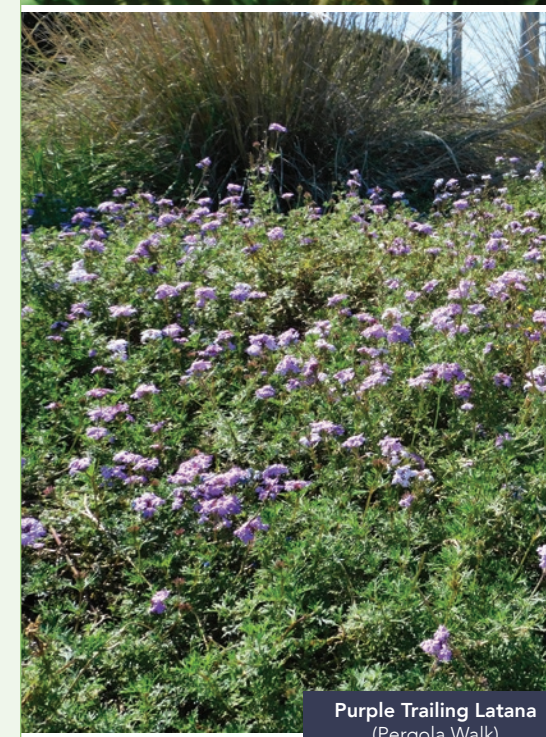

Hats in the Park 2022

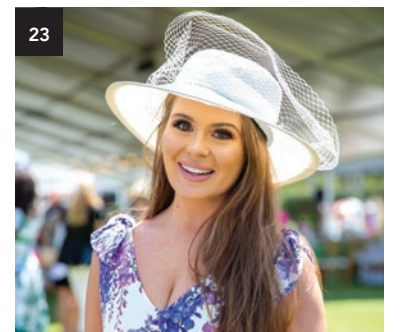

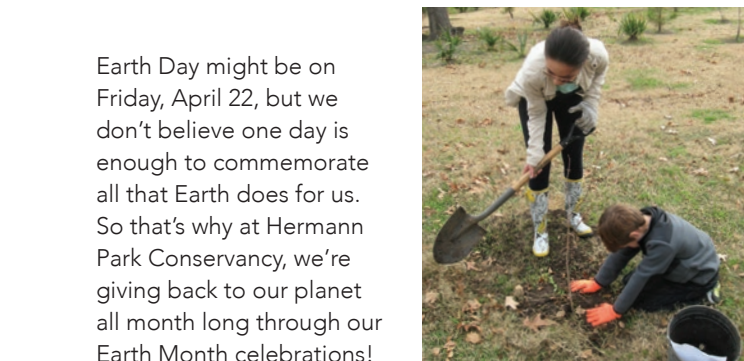
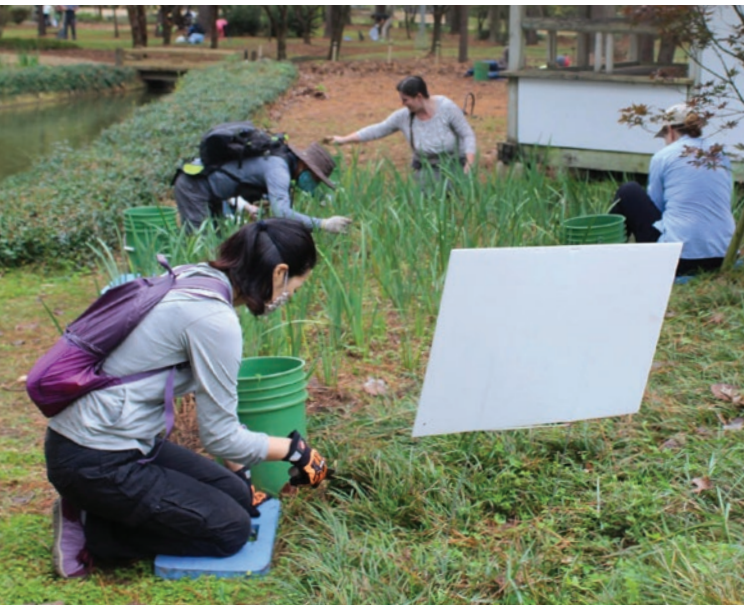
