Celebrating the Next Phase of Hermann Bark

On February 22, 2022, Hermann Park Conservancy officially broke ground on the McWilliams Dog Park. Humans and canines alike came together to celebrate the latest improvement project in Hermann Park.

Bordered by MacGregor Drive and Brays Bayou at the southern tip of the Park, the McWilliams Dog Park is a 2.6-acre site, with dedicated spaces for large and small dogs, interactive water features, canine play equipment, ample shade for dogs and their owners, and dedicated on-site parking. When creating the new master plan, a new dog park was the most requested feature from the community. Now, after many rounds of design and troubleshooting, Hermann Park's furry friends will finally have a place of their own when the McWilliams Dog Park opens this winter.
