On June 10, Hermann Park Conservancy and PNC held a ribbon-cutting ceremony to officially open the new PNC ImagiNature Playground in Hermann Park. These innovative outdoor play spaces are made possible by a \$100,000 grant from the PNC Foundation's \$500 million early childhood education initiative, PNC Grow Up Great, which seeks to prepare children from birth to age 5 for success in school and life.

As part of PNC's Grow Up Great initiative, this play space gives children an opportunity to explore, play, and

imagine as they develop healthy minds and bodies. Taking inspiration from nature such as boulders, wildlife and forests, the seven interactive areas encourage young Hermann Park visitors to play their own way.

The PNC ImagiNature Playground was designed by landscape architects White Oak Studio. In addition, understory plants have been donated by Trees for Houston to further the Conservancy's reforestation efforts, with additional support provided by Landscape Art, and A&A Stone and Masonry.

If you watch the video linked in the QR on the back page of this newsletter, you will see a beautiful close up of Astro and Bella. And even though they are gorgeous Brittanys and seem perfect in every way, Astro was put up for adoption by his first family. Brad and Laura have been involved in fostering Brittanys for years and, well, when someone gives up their pure-bred dog, usually the reason is far from good.

And so it was with poor Astro whose previous family had given up on him because he chewed through all the wiring for their air conditioner. Laura and Brad took him in as a foster to give him a chance at a better home—and Astro guickly let them know that their home was pretty much the perfect home, and so the foster became an eventual adoption. And so far, the air conditioner is safe.

Not all of their foster dogs have been "foster fails" that they went on to adopt, but even for those fosters they help find another home, Laura and Brad will literally go the extra mile. One sweet dog named Jemma was so feisty that she "drove the McWilliams dogs to despair," according to Laura. A potential adopter in San Antonio asked to keep her for the weekend and Laura and Brad drove her all the way there—only to drive her right back to Houston after she terrorized the

potential adopter's dogs too. However, a couple of months later, the mother of the San Antonio adopter called saying she had met Jemma and was sure they would get along great, so back to San Antonio Laura and Brad drove to give Jemma a new home.

For any of us who has loved a dog we know that your heart breaks when they leave us all too soon. So Lulu wanted to make sure you heard about the two sister Brittanys Laura and Brad adopted when they were nine years old after their owner passed away. As if adopting senior gals wasn't big hearted enough, they flew the dogs from their former home in Bend, Oregon to Colorado, where Laura and Brad were staying and drove five hours to the Denver airport to pick them up. This story does have a sweet and happy ending. One sister lived to be 17 and was the cheeriest member of the McWilliams family.

Thanks to Laura and Brad for their wonderful gift to the doggies who are all part of the Conservancy family. Lulu and I will see you in the Park,



Next time you're in the Park, be sure to take an extra special moment to admire al of the wonderful blooms and color after one of the toughest winters Houston has






Hermann Park Conservancy members all join for different reasons. Some want to support urban conservation and wildlife habitat preservation, some want to share the joy they had as children playing in Hermann Park with their own children, and some just love riding the train.

But regardless of why people join, one thing all members have in common is that they are all

supporting vital operational needs in Hermann Park, which helps us keep it looking better than ever. And just how do memberships do that exactly?

- A Bronze membership buys 24 pairs of garden gloves for staff and volunteers to work in the Park.
- A Centennial membership buys weeding tools for 20 volunteers to remove invasive species from the Park's plant beds.
- A Gold membership purchases a portable water tank to water newly-planted trees during drought conditions.
- A Platinum membership purchases 1.5 acres of Coastal Prairie Seed Mix to help restore the natural habitat of the migratory
- A Conductor's Circle membership purchases 20 native trees to plant in the Park.

# Volunteers Give Back to Hermann Park

It has been a busy few months in the Park for our Conservancy volunteers. In April, a new initiative was kicked off that challenged the public to help log 1,000 volunteer hours throughout the month to celebrate Earth Day. The public answered and was able to log 1,210 hours, totaling over \$30,000 of labor impact in the Park!

In addition to individual efforts, Conservancy members came out on April 10 for Love Your Park volunteer day to help plant Asiatic jasmine along the Marvin Taylor Trail to help reduce soil erosion under the tree canopy. A number of organizations such as Keller Williams, Motiva, Phillips 66, and the Houston Texans also held dedicated volunteer days in Hermann Park. With their help, we were able to plant over 100 trees and understory plants, restore 70 benches, and remove silt and debris from the Japanese Garden streams.
