After six years of planning, nearly one year of construction, and over 2,000 plantings later, the renovation of Lott Hall is finally complete. Originally designed by Alfred E. Nutter and built in 1933, it served as the Hermann Park Golf Course clubhouse until 1999, and was then the home of Hermann Park Conservancy and City of Houston's Hermann Park administration offices until 2015. With the goal of preserving and repurposing the historic elements, the Conservancy first began plans for renovation in 2014 as part of its centennial campaign. Thanks to a generous leading gift from Sherry and Tommy Lott, that plan became a reality.

The clubhouse is an important part of Hermann Park's history and the Conservancy wanted to uphold the tradition of gathering and celebration with a new way to enjoy a unique part of the city's past. In order to do this, the Conservancy partnered with Houston First to become one of the first organizations in Houston to participate in the federal and state historic tax credits

program through leasing a city-owned building, which helps incentivize renovating historic buildings in the city's inventory instead of tearing them down. Earned income from events such as weddings at Lott Hall will go towards funding the Conservancy's stewardship programs in the Park.

The restoration plans for the building, by Curtis & Windham Architects, are embellished by landscaping designed by Michael Van Valkenburgh Associates. Featuring a melting pot of plantings from different climates and cultures, the gardens perfectly capture the spirit of Houston.



Obviously, the freeze wreaked havoc on these beautiful blooms—but with your help and the remarkable efforts of the Hermann Park Conservancy team we know they will be back to greet us next spring.

On January 2, 2021 I celebrated my 18th anniversary with the Conservancy. Over those years, I have seen the Park recover from Hurricanes Ike and Harvey as well as the horrific drought. 
# Blast from the Past: Mary Gibbs and Jesse H. Jones Reflection Pool

To many Park visitors, the gracious Jones Reflection Pool is all they've ever known. After all, it has been in its renewed state for 17 years. However, more seasoned visitors to Hermann Park may remember a time when muddy slopes and families of ducks had overrun the edges of the water.

Plans to remodel the Jones Reflection Pool came to fruition as part of the Conservancy's 1995 master plan. As part of that process, artist Elizabeth Day created a watercolor

showcasing what the renovated Jones Reflection Pool might look and feel like, using nothing but the preliminary plans and her imagination.

The Jones Reflection Pool was dedicated in 2003 and has been one of the favorite spots in Hermann Park ever since. With the next master plan currently under way, the Conservancy is hard at work creating plenty more favorite spots for the next generation of Park visitors.



# If You Plant It, They Will Come

The Commons is shaping up to be an incredible place filled with community spaces, play areas, and natural vistas. However, before any of that can be built, there needs to be a good foundation. So our Urban Land Management team has gone out to the site and planted lots and lots of daikon radishes!

This unassuming and delicious vegetable is actually serving a critical purpose in preparing the land before future plantings or construction of the Commons begins. The Conservancy team planted 65 pounds of radish seed over seven acres in order to revitalize and nourish the old and compacted soil currently in the area. However instead of harvesting them, these radishes will actually stay and decompose in the ground, helping break up and provide essential nutrients to restore the soil.
